Hilary has signed contracts from all but two judges. Hilary is wondering if we can do a (Fair Seedling) program for kids ages 3-5 years not in Kindergarten. No registration needed, no judging, but the child will receive a ribbon. Will have a spot in the Jr. Fair Building to show their projects. Everyone said it's a fantastic idea. It's all ago.
 - g. Other- Thad- Four Wheeler for Garbage pick-up May's Sportscenter will have on grounds. Randy Dietzel (BaySide Veterinary) will be on the grounds Wednesday, Thursday, Friday working fair only and will leave on an emergency basis. Lily Bay taking manure again. Sheriff Reserve on board. the works of it being done and ready to go. Need to look at something else for banners. The vinyl is starting to come off (can look into that in the future).
